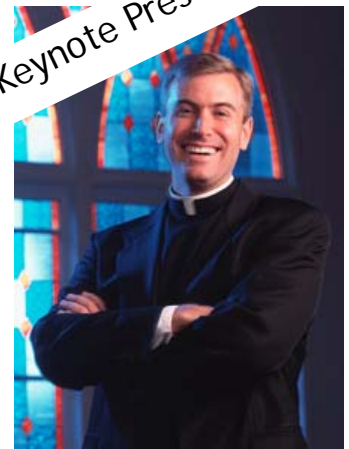

Directions to St. Peter, Libertytown

From I-70

Take I-70 go exit 627 MD 75. Take MD 75 North about 8 miles to MD 26. Stay straight on MD 75 past MD 26. St. Peter's is on your left. About a block past MD 26.

From the Beltway via MD 26

Take Beltway Exit 18, liberty Road towards Randallstown. Pass Liberty Reservoir , Eldersberg, and Unionville. At MD 75, turn right. St, Peter's is about 1 block down on MD 75, on the left.
